Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to appoint a public-at-large member to the Fort Saskatchewan Policing Committee.

Background:

The City of Fort Saskatchewan has recently received the resignation of Daryl Stubbington, public-at-large member to the Fort Saskatchewan Policing Committee. As a result of this resignation, the Application Review Committee is recommending the appointment of Cameron McCormick to the Fort Saskatchewan Policing Committee.

The Application Review Committee, consisting of Councillor Sheldon Bossert, as well as a representative and administrative liaison from the Fort Saskatchewan Policing Committee conducted interviews on November 26, 2014. Three applicants, including Cameron McCormick, were interviewed for the two vacancies on the Committee. Ian McDonell and Zeljka Mikelic-Strazza were previously appointed by Council to fill the two vacancies on the Committee. As outlined in Council Policy GOV-007-C, applications are retained on file for a period of six month, should a future vacancy occur.

- 1. That Council approve the appointment of Cameron McCormick to the Fort Saskatchewan Policing Committee.
- 2. That Council not approve the appointment of Cameron McCormick to the Fort Saskatchewan Policing Committee, and advise how they wish to proceed.
