### **Motion:**

#### Purpose:

To seek Council support for Incident Command System (ICS) role-specific training through the intermunicipal collaboration component of the Alberta Community Partnership Grant.

## **Background:**

Strathcona County, as managing partner and in partnership with Fort Saskatchewan, Edmonton, Leduc and Spruce Grove, is making application through the intermunicipal collaboration portion of the Alberta Community Partnership Grant for ICS training in the amount of \$50,000.00.
