

BYLAW C13-16

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF FORT SASKATCHEWAN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO CLOSE A ROAD, BEING A PORTION OF GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE ADJOINING RIVER LOT 21 - POINT AUX PINS

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Fort Saskatchewan, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

 That all that portion of government road allowance lying within the limits of the Subject Area,

FORT SASKATCHEWAN SETTLEMENT ALL THAT PORTION OF ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE ADJOINING RIVER LOT 21 (WITHIN THEO. MERIDIAN 4 RANGE 23 TOWNSHIP 54 SECTION 24) LYING WITHIN LOT 1MR, BLOCK 1, PLAN 162____ (IN 2 PARTS) EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS.

as shown on the attached Schedule "A", be closed.

- 2. That Council declare the portion of land created by this Road Closure Bylaw as surplus for municipal purposes.
- 3. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.
- 4. That Bylaw No. C13-16 becomes effective upon third and final reading.
